

# CLASS PERMIT No. 095-TH-08

Transport Operations  
(Road Use Management) Act 1995



This PERMIT is issued under the provisions of the *Transport Operations (Road Use Management – Mass, Dimensions and Loading) Regulation 2005, Part 6 Division 2 – Permits*, and is a means of alternative compliance with the provisions of the *"Guideline for Multi-combination Vehicles in Queensland, Form Number 1"*, section 5.1.2.

Pursuant to Section 51 (1) of the *Transport Operations (Road Use Management – Mass, Dimensions and Loading) Regulation 2005*, it is hereby approved to drive the vehicles mentioned herein on a road, subject to the following conditions:

1. Vehicles covered by this Permit: B-double combinations longer than 25 metres, but not longer than **26 metres**.
2. Permit period: **27 May 2008** to and including **31 November 2008**, unless sooner revoked by the Chief Executive of Queensland Transport or his delegate.
3. Approved Routes:
  - All road train and 25 metre B-double routes identified in maps titled "B-double and road train routes in Queensland" prepared by Queensland Transport and included in the *"Guideline for Multi-combination Vehicles in Queensland, Form Number 1"*.
  - All 25 metre B-double routes currently approved in permits issued by Queensland Transport.
4. The distance between the point of articulation at the front of the leading semitrailer and the rear of the vehicle combination must not be greater than **20.6 metres**.
5. Queensland Transport reserves the right to amend or withdraw this permit as policy is further developed.
6. Please note Queensland Transport is currently developing a process for the approval for Front Underrun Protection System (FUPS) and cabin strength. Once this process is finalised, it will be a requirement for operators to meet the following requirements:
  - Prime mover of the combination is fitted with FUPS that complies with Regulation No. 93 of the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe (UNECE);
  - Prime mover is fitted with a cab that complies with Regulation No. 29 of the UNECE if it has a date of manufacture after 31 December 2005.
